The listed documents are to be presented personally;
please provide an original and two legible copies

- Passport (cannot be older than 10 years and must have at least two blank pages)
- Nationals other than Tanzanians must show a valid residence permit for Tanzania
- 2 Application forms („National Visa“) duly filled in and signed by the applicant
- 2 identical passport size photographs (biometric) with bright background and not older than 3 months
- Proof of medical insurance for the beginning of the stay
- Letter of invitation and proof of financial means of relative living in Germany with copy of identity card/passport and - where applicable- copy of German resident permit

For spouses:

- Birth certificate (legalised by German Embassy)*
- Certificate of marriage (legalised) / where applicable divorce papers of previous marriage
- Evidence of German language ability (Level A1); Goethe-Institut and TestDaF certificates are accepted. Parents of German children do not need to present a language certificate

For minor children:

- Birth certificate (legalised by German Embassy)*
- Official court ruling regarding custody proving sole custody of parent living in Germany
- For single parent: An affidavit sworn at the office of a notary public that the other parent has no custody of the child and that biological parents have never lived together
- Death certificate of deceased parent

* Please note that the Embassy can only legalise documents being issued by RITA (Registration, Insolvency and Trusteeship Agency) in Dar es Salaam.

If considered necessary, the Embassy reserves the right to request additional documents.
Application forms have to be filled in completely, otherwise the application cannot be processed.
Processing fees (60 Euro) must be paid in local currency (Tsh) on the basis of the current exchange rate.
Processing will take up to 8 weeks.
